

FLEX EDUCATION SERIES Timberflex Framework Fabrication

OVERVIEW

- All vertical ribs should be set slightly back from the horizontal ribs so they will not interfere in the forming of the material.
- Only attach to flush vertical rib when forming a seam.

Let's get started!



Use traditional methods to construct the framework.



Glue, screws and staples are all suitable for construction.



To attach Timberflex the framework should consist of horizontal ribs.


PRO TIP:

Vertical ribs are only necessary for supporting and positioning the horizontal ribs. They are not needed for attaching Timberflex.

TIP: Taller fixtures may require more ribs.

In most applications atleast three ribs are recommended.
