THE CHALLENGE

To create leatherbound columns for the dining area of Del Frisco's Double Eagle Steakhouse in San Diego, California. The columns required a material that would be:

- ✓ **Flexible.**
To form around the curve of the columns.
- ✓ **Stable.**
To support Ecodomo's leather veneers.
- ✓ **Smooth.**
To ensure Ecodomo's leather finish would appear seamless.

THE SOLUTION

Kerfkore's Flexboard, which features the necessary flexibility, stability, and a smooth Eucalyptus Hardboard face. Flexboard's precision design and higher quality materials ensures a consistent and even curved surface that does not telegraph. Ecodomo did not have to waste time fixing imperfections that you often get with traditional products. For the finish, Ecodomo utilized their Barley Harvest Distressed Buffalo leather veneers with gold stitching and attached the leather-finished Flexboard panels to the columns with French Cleats.
